As you may well be aware Room 24 and 25 have this year offered a Māori-infused programme of learning. In essence this programme of learning and teaching, within these spaces, has involved a much higher percentage of Māori language, culture and tikanga than would normally be found in a mainstream classroom. We are able to offer this programme as we have had fluent speakers of te reo, Pā Ronald and Whaea Katy. Our aim is to expand this programme further in 2020 and provide a pathway for our kids to have elements of Māori education enhanced whilst following a mainstream classroom programme. It is hoped that classes will run from Year 1-4, although this is dependent on numbers. Currently, the students within these rooms are being surveyed to see if they wish to continue with this initiative. Once we have received this feedback the programme will be offered to other children in these year groups in 2020. Please keep an eye out for further information.
